District 7 History – West Gate #128

West Gate Lodge No. 128 was chartered June 10, 1903 at Seattle. As one of the three gates important to Masonic legend, West Gate also has the reason that Seattle Is the west gate to the nation from the ports on Puget Sound. They had met at the old Main Masonic Temple in Seattle from the time it was built. They moved to the Bellevue Masonic Temple In June of 1975 as the declining membership in downtown Seattle and the potential population that Bellevue offered for new members looked promising for Lodge growth. From 1955, to 1970 the Lodge had dropped from 450 members to 222. The move did not stop the decline, as the members now number 117 in 1994, but It Is an active Lodge with good prospects for the future. In 1986 the Lodge looked for a Charity to support and Eastside Literacy Council was chosen. Member donations were matched by the Lodge, and material support, tutors and a member for the board of directors were provided to the Council by the Lodge. This Charity finally found strong supporters by 1993 and the Lodge moved its support to the Seattle Valley of the Scottish Rite Center for Childhood Language Disorders. They donated \$2,500, which is enough for tuition for one child for one year. This Lodge has tried to find more interesting affairs for its members and in 1993 the Lodge sponsored the Masonic Float In two Seattle Seafair parades, has started a program of visitations and has held Table Lodges. Plans are being made to write the Lodge's Centennial History for the great event in the year 2003.
