While we lick our plates clean the food bank line will still be there, on Thanksgiving Day and every day.

District 7 History – Unity #198

Unity Lodge No. 198 was Chartered June 11, 1913 at North Bend in King County. There are 34 Unity Lodges in the United States. This town was originally called Snoqualmie and platted by W.H. Taylor who settled there in 1872. It also was called Mountain View and

South Fork, but it was renamed North Bend because it is situated where the South fork of the Snoqualmie River bends to the North, and is located very close to the summit of Snoqualmie Pass. In 1979 the Lodge started its first annual Widow's Night and they also hold a Salmon Bar-B-Que during the North Bend Annual Celebration, which has proven to be a fairly good income project for the Lodge. The Lodge does many activities each year, such as Past Master's Night and a Homecoming Dinner, the members look forward to these events and enjoy fellowship together. In 1994 this Lodge had 84 members.
