Goodbye Rocketman

I was in second grade in 1962 when Brother John Glenn became the first human to orbit the earth. He traveled to space again aboard the space shuttle in 1998 to become the oldest person on record to travel to space. Last Thursday he departed for one final journey, this time to the Celestial Lodge.



Brother Glenn was elected to receive his degrees in 1964, but due to a busy life of public service was not raised until 1978. In 1998 he was conferred the 33rd degree. Other than a few brief acknowledgements of his membership in our Fraternity there isn't much published about his Masonic career. But there's a lot about his other careers.

He flew 149 combat missions as a US Marine in both World War II and the Korean War. He then became a test pilot before joining NASA in 1958. Starting in 1974 he represented Ohio in the US Senate for 15 years.

Amazingly, in this modern age and living constantly in the public eye, our good Brother Glen was not once involved or implicated in any political scandal.

Occasionally we get to travel on a brief journey into the "rare air". Brother Glenn spent a lifetime there.

District 7 History – Mercer Island #297

Mercer Island Lodge No. 297 was Chartered June 16, 1954 on Mercer Island in King County. This island and the town were named for Judge Thomas Mercer, who was captain of a wagon train that arrived in Seattle in 1853. He also named Lake Washington and Lake Union. When the Lake Washington Floating Bridge was built the island population grew greatly and the need for a Lodge in the area was seen by local Masons. This Lodge has participated In a Junior student Award for 25 years. They have had a Senior student Scholarship for 15 years, which has grown to two awards for \$1,000.00 each. They take their Lodge widows Easter lilies and Christmas poinsettias, and also include them in their Ladies nights. A special program of the Lodge is providing free Kid's Identification Cards to almost 280 children. This is accomplished at local fairs, and promotes identification of children so that In case they become missing, the police and other law agencies will have information and a picture of them to use in the search. The Lodge also annually gives \$500 to the Northwest Multiple Service Center and has an educational talk at each meeting. Membership has ranged from a high of 136 down to the current 104, with attendance running about 20% of the membership even though about 25% percent live outside the Puget Sound area. The Lodge meets at the Mercer Island Veterans of Foreign Wars Hall and is getting some younger members, which will help the Lodge grow In the next few years.
